

# April Book of the Month

#### CHRIST FROM BEGINNING TO END

An excerpt from BibleGateway How the Whole Bible Speaks of Jesus: An Interview with Stephen Wellum By Jonathan Petersen

The title of your book is, Christ from Beginning to End. Explain the title and then a few unique features of your book. Stephen Wellum: The title echoes a beautiful verse at the end of our Bibles, when the Lord Jesus says, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end" (Rev 22:13). "Christ from beginning to end" is a nice way of capturing the truth that the universe, our triune God's plan of salvation, and our very lives are through and for the Lord Jesus Christ (Col 1:15-23).

One of our priorities in this project was to teach but also reinforce the Bible's internal covenantal structure. So we structured our book to teach and reinforce the Bible's own internal divisions. For example, "Noah: A Boat Full of Life," "Moses: A Mountain Full of Smoke," and "Jesus: A Cup Full of Blood." We hope this imagery and story-telling helps project the story onto the reader's imagination and heart.

What do you mean when you write, "What if the Bible's many characters, events, and places are not in the way of getting to know Jesus but are the way to know him?"

**Stephen Wellum:** This statement is another way of saying that nothing in Scripture is accidental. Since Scripture is God's Word that unfolds his eternal plan of redemption, everything from creation, God's rest on the seventh day, the creation of Adam and us as image-bearers, to Eden as a Garden-temple sanctuary, to the establishment of prophets, priests, and kings, etc., is for a purpose. No doubt, we only come to know how the Bible's


characters, events, and places fit in God's plan by carefully reading the story, but they're there for a reason. What we try to demonstrate, by a careful reading of Scripture, and tracing out the Bible's own presentation of itself, is how the Bible's characters, events, and places lead us to Jesus.

You group sections of the Old Testament to describe the ways Jesus is revealed: creation, fall, redemption, Noah, Abraham, Moses, David, and the Prophets. Briefly explain.

Stephen Wellum: Let's focus on creation, fall, and the promise of redemption. We begin with creation because this is where the Bible's story begins. That may seem a bit trite but it's of profound significance. In creation, we're introduced to who God is, who we are and our role in creation, the headship of Adam, and other significant truths that are important in this context but which also point beyond themselves to their ultimate fulfillment in Christ.

In creation we learn that we were created good, which soon changes in the fall (Genesis 3). We also quickly learn that unless God acts in grace we're without hope. God's rest in creation and our enjoyment of his presence in Eden, both lost in the fall, anticipate, because of God's promise (Gen 3:15) that God will provide someone from the human race who will restore rest, presence, and defeat sin and death.

Beginning in creation and seeing the effects of sin in all of its disastrous aspects, establishes the nature of our human problem before God and why Jesus



must come. It also anticipates something of what our Lord's work will accomplish: namely, to pay for our sin before God and ultimately to usher in a new creation. As for Noah, Abraham, Moses, and David, what's important to stress is that it's through the biblical covenants that God reveals his plan and establishes the typological patterns which alone make sense of who Jesus is and his glorious reconciling work.

#### What do you want the book to achieve in the lives of its readers?

**Stephen Wellum:** First, to know God's Word better so that we understand better how the parts fit with the whole and are led to greater appreciation for Scripture. Second, to be amazed at the wisdom of our triune God as we reflect on his glorious plan of redemption. Third, to be renewed in our understanding of the gospel with full conviction of its truthfulness which translates to greater devotion to our calling in this life to know, love, obey, and enjoy God and to make him known.

# The Messenger

Please join the Shiloh Kids this Easter Sunday, April 21, 2019, for their "Resurrection Celebration". This year's theme for their celebration is "The Messenger", Mark 16:5-6 – And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed. And he said to them, Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has risen; he is not here. See the place where they laid him.

We know that Jesus was falsely accused, tortured, beaten and hung to die on the cross. He was then placed in a borrowed tomb, following his crucifixion. We know that a large stone was rolled in front of the tomb's opening and a guard was placed outside of it, so no one could steal his body. We also know that He rose on the third day and that He is Alive today! But what do we know about the messenger, the angel who was appointed to deliver the good news about His resurrection?

## SHILOH KIDS PRESENTS "THE MESSENGER," A STORY TOLD FROM A KID'S PERSPECTIVE:

How did the stone get rolled away from the entry of the tomb? Who folded Jesus' burial clothing and placed them neatly in the tomb? Who was there, waiting at the tomb for the women, when they would come to anoint the body of Jesus with spices, to inform them that He was not there? The Jr. Angel Ed, the Messenger, appointed by the Angel Gabriel. He is tasked with delivering the great news, but is toiling on how to deliver the message. He was wondering why him and what God saw in him to select him over more noteworthy Angels such as Gabriel or Michael, to be the one to deliver the news. He did not feel worthy and didn't want to disappoint Gabriel, but even more so he did not want to disappoint God. It was hard for him to contain himself, first to have sat where Jesus' body had lain and to be given such an important job, the one to make the announcement to the world that "He is Risen!"

Yes, "He is Risen!" is the message that Christians carry to the world every day. As you are preparing for Holy Week, and perhaps you will be entertaining guests, you have a grand opportunity to be a messenger for Christ. You can share with friends and family that the resurrection of Jesus Christ is the most important event in all human history. Jesus died on the cross for our sins. He is the only great spiritual leader and teacher who actually rose from the dead. The fact that "He is Risen!" makes the message of Christianity different from every other spiritual teaching and system on the face of the earth. HIS resurrection proved beyond a shadow of a doubt that Jesus is God! And amazingly He invites you into a personal relationship with Him. How does a person become a Christian? This is how we share in Shiloh Kids Ministry:

Admit to God that you are a sinner. Repent, turn away from your sin. (Romans 3:23, Acts 3:19; 1 John 1:9)

Believe that Jesus is God's Son and accept God's gift of forgiveness from sin. (Acts 16:31; John 14:6)

Confess your faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. (Romans 10:9-10, 13)

We were all incredibly proud of our youth on Sunday, and we were honored to witness ministry. Do not give up on the next generation; do not lose faith; they are just getting started!







# Sovereign Grace Recap

The recording process of the Shiloh and Sovereign Grace recording began for me on January 14th of this year when I was invited to a special writing and arranging session. The purpose of this session was to create new, original songs for this project. This was a foundational time that set the tone for the remainder of the process. This writing retreat was led by Shiloh's own - Pastor Joe Pace and by the leader of Sovereign Grace Music, Bob Kauflin. Those two shared their hearts and vision with the room as they expressed what they would like to see the project accomplish. We all agreed that Christ-centered, God glorifying music is what we wanted to produce from our time together. That writing retreat lasted three days and great songs were written that we were sure would have a major impact on the project and those who listened to it.

However, during those three days there was also something else happening that would prove to be greatly impactful, we were fellowshipping and learning from one another. In a sense, I believe a greater purpose was being fulfilled. The obvious optics say that this is a predominantly white organization that is doing an album with a predominantly black church and the differences and hurdles must be many.

We indeed did discover that there were differences. Differences in style and in approach, and even in preference. But, we never disagreed on what God's truths were and that would prove to be our guiding light throughout the entire process.

The week of the recording was intense. There were many rehearsals and run throughs and production elements that had to be executed, but what we discovered on a daily basis was the ability to worship and engage our God together in unity.

Our differences in style and approach seemed to melt away in the presence of God and we quickly realized that we were witnessing the goal being accomplished.

I walked away from this experience with an appreciation for the differences and the diversity in worship and praise. Many of us have made these things a hang-up or a point of contention and separation, but God, who is the lover and ruler of all isn't hung up on these things. He's concerned with the truth - the truth of His Word being shared and revealed in the earth.

I'm so thankful to be a part of a church like Shiloh that has the vision and desire to reach beyond the lines and barriers in order to truly accomplish God's great commission . . . Matthew 28:16-20.


