Shiloh Kids COVID Protocol

OBJECTIVE

This document was written to provide parents and/or guardians our statement for re-opening our Shiloh Kids Ministry. We want to provide a safe environment for our children and families. This plan is not flawless; however, it does provide our best efforts to ensure a safe ministry experience for children. The leadership of Shiloh Church will update this document, as needed, based on reports from the CDC.

MEASURES TO REDUCE THE COVID-19 SPREAD TEMPERATURE SCREENING

We are requiring parents to be proactive by checking your children's temperature before they leave home. If a temperature of 100.4 or higher is discovered, your child should stay home to avoid contaminating others or becoming sicker. Per CDC guidelines, children should be fever-free for 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.

SOCIAL DISTANCING/FACE COVERINGS will do our best to maximize social distancing in the classroom. Face coverings for children is at the parent's discretion.

CLEANING AND SANITIZING will be ongoing to ensure that opportunities for germs to linger or cling to surfaces will be minimized. Teachers will receive a supply of disinfectant wipes and spray. Teachers will also teach the children that keeping their workspace clean is very important for assisting with minimizing the spread of COVID-19.

WELLNESS AND CONTACT SCREENING

To minimize the risk of spreading the virus to other children or volunteers, stay home if you or your child show the following signs or symptoms:

- Elevated temperature 100.4 or above
- New loss of smell or taste
- Sudden chills
- New cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Nausea, diarrhea
- Close contact for more than 15 minutes with someone diagnosed with COVID-19
- Someone at home diagnosed with COVID-19 or is having symptoms as listed above
- Travel to any part of the country experiencing high rates of infections

SNACKS for Pre-K will be pre-packaged and each child will be given a bottle of water. For elementary age, snacks will be distributed as children leave for the day.
